Addlestone Hebrew Academy uses FACTS Tuition Management to 1.) manage tuition payment plans and 2.) to provide the first step in financial needs assessment for our families in need of tuition assistance.

Tuition Management

All families who are making monthly tuition payments *must* apply to use FACTS for tuition management. You will be able to apply on-line at www.factsmgt.com when you receive your bill.

Tuition Assistance

Applications for tuition assistance are available online at www.factstuitionaid.com for students in Kindergarten thru 8th grade. Requests for tuition assistance will be addressed based on need and as funds are available as determined by FACTS Management with the ultimate decision of the AHA Scholarship Committee. AHA applies for annual subvention from the Charleston Jewish Federation in support of scholarship funding.

The Scholarship Committee encourages all parents who are applying for tuition assistance to write a letter explaining any extenuating circumstances. These letters should be submitted to the AHA office in a sealed envelope to the attention of The Scholarship Committee.

All information regarding scholarships is kept in strictest confidence.

The deadline for applying for tuition assistance is March 1st. Because there is a fixed amount of scholarship funding available, we must adhere to this deadline. In order to make a fair and timely allocation of the available funds, the scholarship committee will evaluate applications received by FACTS by this deadline.

Please Note:

- FACTS assess an application fee for both tuition management and to apply for tuition assistance.
- **Registration, lunch and building/security fees are not eligible for reduction or scholarship.**
