

Spelling Study Activities

- Write words in your best cursive.
- Write words 3 or 5 or 10 times each.
- Write words in alphabetical order.
- Write words and circle the vowels.
- Write words and underline the consonants.
- Write words and divide them into syllables.
- Write words and their definitions.
- Write words in sentences.
- Write the entire word in upper case letters.
- Use the words to play hangman.
- Use the words and <http://puzzlemaker.school.discovery.com/> to create crossword puzzles, word searches, etc. Then print and solve.
- Illustrate/draw what the word means.
- Sort words: by the number of letters, by parts of speech, by number of syllables, etc.
- Calculate a "Words Worth." Use this code to figure out the value of each word: A = 1¢, B = 5¢, C = 10¢, D = 25¢, E = 50¢, F = 25¢, G = 10¢, H = 5¢, I = 1¢, J = 1¢, K = 5¢, L = 10¢, M = 25¢, N = 50¢, O = 25¢, P = 10¢, Q = 5¢, R = 1¢, S = 1¢, T = 5¢, U = 10¢, V = 25¢, W = 50¢, X = 25¢, Y = 10¢, Z = 5¢. Example: Porter-Gaud = 10¢ + 25¢ + 1¢ + 5¢ + 50¢ + 1¢ + 10¢ + 1¢ + 10¢ + 25¢ = 138¢ = \$1.38
- Create and solve word scrambles. This page <http://www.teach-nology.com/cgi-bin/scramble.pl> may be helpful.
- Write words in alliterative sentences.
- Write words in similes.
- Rainbow Words. Write words and trace over them with crayons or markers.
- Backwards Words. Write words correctly then write them backwards.
- Write riddles for the words.
- Connect the Dots. Write the letters of each word in dots then connect the dots to spell each word.
- Write each word then write a rhyming word for each one.
